Template Data Reporting for First Nations Schools

In January 2012, the BC First Nations Education Steering Committee (FNESEC), the Government of Canada, and the Government of British Columbia signed a Tripartite Education Framework Agreement (TEFA). This new agreement provides First Nations with funding for their schools that is based on the BC Ministry of Education's Operating Grants Manual, with specific adaptations.

According to TEFA, First Nations in BC must submit to Canada the annual AANDC nominal roll.

First Nations also must provide performance indicator data to the FNSA/FNESEC. This information will then be submitted to AANDC in aggregate, and it is to be shared with parents at the community level.

Specifically, the AANDC Funding Agreement and the TEFA Agreement itself state:

“The Council shall make an aggregate outcome report on school performance available annually to parents of students attending a First Nation School.”

The following represents the key data our school has submitted to the FNSA/FNESEC for 2012/2013.

We hope that sharing this information with parents and our community will help to promote informed and thoughtful discussion about how we can all work together to help support the outcomes we want for our students.
