CRITERIA:

The bursary will be awarded to one full-time post-secondary student who is enrolled in the 2010-2011 academic year from the TSAWOUT, TSARTLIP, PAUQUACHIN or TSEYCUM Nations and will have demonstrated commitment to Community, Leadership and Volunteer work. The applicant will apply directly to the "Personnel Committee" care of the W̱SÁNEĆ School Board and attach the following:

- Cover letter including work involved in community, leadership roles, activities, volunteer experience
- Letters of Reference: (1 personal, and 2 professional)
- Resume
- Current transcript of academic standing

The applications are reviewed by a member of Gabe Bartleman family, or they choose an alternate as well as members of the Personnel Committee. Please note only completed packages will be reviewed. The amount of the bursary is \$500.00 and eligible students may apply each year even if they have previously applied and were successful recipients.

Consideration is given to all applicants, however only the successful applicant will be contacted. Thank you.
